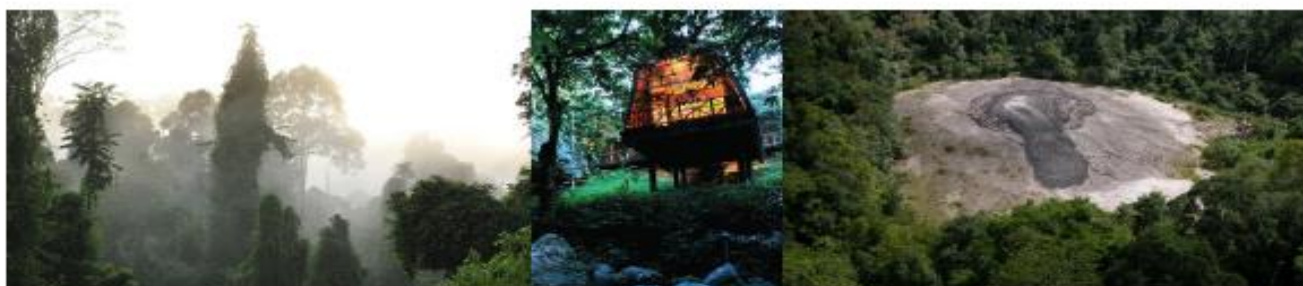


3 DAYS 2 NIGHTS TABIN WILDLIFE



Day One

Meet and greet on your arrival at Lahad Datu Airport (recommended flight on Malaysia Airlines on MH3010 ETD0605hrs / ETA 0705hrs). Proceed journey to Tabin Wildlife Reserve (1½hrs). Check into an attractive timber lodge at Tabin Wildlife Resort, which comes complete with private balcony, air conditioner, ceiling fan and hot water shower, a welcome luxury in the forest. In the afternoon, visit the active Lipad mud volcano which provides a mineral salt lick for wildlife. After trekking through the rainforest for 20 minutes, arrive at the elevated bare area of the mud volcano which is frequented by wildlife and birds. Try to identify the multitude of animal footprints here. The adventurous can try the effects of the volcanic mud, said to be responsible for a fine complexion. Trek back to the resort along elephant trail. After dinner, enjoy a CD/Slide presentation on Tabin's natural wonders, followed by a night safari to look out for nocturnal wildlife and birds.

Day Two

Join the early morning bird walk to discover some of Tabin's rich collection of more than 300 species of birds. After breakfast, a drive to the core area for animal's spotting and for photo session before trekking through the lush green rainforest known for its rich diversity of plants and animal species to visit Lipad Waterfall. Take a dip in the natural pool and enjoy a natural and refreshing shower under the waterfall. Alternatively explore the surrounding vegetation or just relax. In the afternoon, try out the Tabin Rainforest Foot Soak made with a natural blend of herbs, to relax tired muscles after long jungle treks. In the evening, a dusk drive to look out for more nocturnal wildlife & birds coming out to look for food during this time of the day. After dinner, go for a night walk along the trail nearby the resort in search of sleeping birds, frog and nocturnal wildlife.

Day Three

Take up a dawn drive to look out for wildlife that is active at this time of the day. Return to resort for breakfast and free at own leisure. After lunch, depart for Lahad Datu Airport for your flight to Kota Kinabalu (recommended flight on Malaysia Airlines MH3017 ETD1615hrs ETA1710hrs).

3 DAYS 2 NIGHTS BORNEO RAINFOREST LODGE



Day One

Meet and greet on your arrival at Lahad Datu Airport (recommended flight on Malaysia Airlines on MH3010 ETD0605hrs / ETA 0705hrs). After registration at Borneo Rainforest office, transfer to Danum Valley which takes about 2½ drive. Borneo Rainforest Lodge lies within the Danum Valley Conservation Area along the banks of the Danum River in eastern Sabah, Malaysia. The conservation area is Sabah's largest protected area of lowland dipterocarp forest, 43,000 hectares managed for the purposes of conservation, education, training, and research. Besides being home to hundreds of species of birds and reptiles, and some of the largest butterflies and moths in the world, it is also one of the largest remaining sanctuaries for the wild Orang Utan. After check-in in the lodge, take a "Nature Trail" with the guide for an introduction of the forest.

After dinner, take a "Night Drive" in an open-air jeep in search of nocturnal animals.

Day Two

After breakfast, take guided jungle activities - trek to the Kadazandusun burial site – Coffin Cliff then proceed with trekking to the View Point for a bird's eye view of the Danum Valley and the Borneo lowland rainforest. Descend to the Jacuzzi Pool for a refreshing dip. Optional : Water tubing for an hour in the Danum River or Trekking along the Segama River.

In the evening, if weather permits, enjoy a Night Walk around the lodge in search of nocturnal animals.

Day Three

After breakfast, take a guided morning walk at the Segama Trail / Hornbill Trail. Lunch at the lodge then check out. Transfer overland to Lahad Datu airport for your flight to Kota Kinabalu (recommended flight on Malaysia Airlines MH3017 ETD1615hrs ETA1710hrs).

Borneo Passages

4 DAYS 3 NIGHTS KOTA KINABALU



Day One

Meet and greet upon arrival at Kota Kinabalu airport and depart to local restaurant for lunch. Then proceed to Mari Mari Cultural Village. Upon arrival and after a briefing with your village guides, cross over the hanging bridge to arrive at the entrance of the village. Here, you will be ushered to the warmth of different homes of the ethnicities of Sabah. Each home was built by descendants of the tribes they represent – such as the ethnic tribes, namely the Bajau, Kadazan, Rungus, Muruts and others. It offers you a truly genuine experience seeing everything in and around the village lends to its magical prowess of taking you back in time. Not only does this village portray these tribes through the architectural genius of their traditional houses, but also through a range of simulated lives of the olden epoch by

the residents of the village. Acquaint yourself with each tribe as they let you come into their house and their simple yet intricate lives. As you traverse the village, you will find demonstration huts along the main houses in which daily activities of old times come into life. For example, the making of blowpipe, starting a fire (from bamboo tree – you will learn the steps of making fire without the help of a lighter), tattoo-making (and its symbolisms) and more. Later, proceed to see the cultural show performed by the village guides and you will be welcomed to join in the performance. High Tea at Mari Mari Cultural Village.

Return to Kota Kinabalu and transfer to selected hotel for check-in and refresh.

Day Two

Meet at hotel and depart to Kinabalu Park. Enroute, brief stopover at Nabalu Market. Kinabalu National Park – Malaysia's 1st World Heritage site, home to half of the world flowering plants species it is also fame for the Majestic Mt. Kinabalu (4,095m). Visit the Education Centre upon arrival to appreciate the botanical wonders of Kinabalu Park. Visit the Mountain Garden to identify the various species of pitcher plants, orchids, ferns, mountain oaks, some of which can only be found in Borneo. Later proceed to Poring Hot Spring set amidst a lowland rainforest. Take a walk through the treetop canopy walkway to get closer to nature – listening to the chirping of birds or sound of insects will surely chase away the stress of city life. You may opt to sooth your body in the hot sulphuric spring water known to possess therapeutic power (please bring along change of clothes & towel).

Day Three

Today we are heading to the nearby Tunku Abdul Rahman Park. A short boat ride will take you to a boomerang shaped island called Manukan. Here you will have your own free leisure time to enjoy the white sandy beach and the crystal clear water. You may opt for swimming, snorkeling or try some of the watersport activities (own expense). For those who likes to take a walk can take the short well marked trail. Enjoy your sumptuous BBQ Lunch. Later in the afternoon, we head back to the mainland. Return to mainland and transfer back to your hotel.

Borneo Passages

4 DAYS 3 NIGHTS SANDAKAN & KINABATANGAN WETLANDS RESORT



Day One

Meet and greet upon arrival at Sandakan Airport and transfer to your resort for check-in.

Overnight stay at Sepilok Nature Resort – Standard Chalet

Day Two

After breakfast, a short walk to Sepilok Orang Utan Rehabilitation Centre. Proceed for an experience - a close encounter with the "Wildman of Borneo". See how tamed Orang Utans that are being rehabilitated into the wild. Walk 10 minutes through the rainforest on wooden boardwalks. A boardwalk leads you to a viewing gallery and feeding platform where the apes are fed milk and bananas twice a day at 10.00am and 3.00pm by rangers. Watch the scheduled video documentary show at the Sepilok Information and Audio Visual building. The 25 minutes video show will give you a better understanding of the Rehabilitation Process and Programs for the Orang Utans in Sepilok Centre and its threats to survival.



Then depart to Sandakan Yacht Club Jetty and transfer by boat to Abai, Kinabatangan. The cruise shall bypass Berhala Island. The prominent sandstone cliffs are a historical site during the World War II. The journey also offers chances to observe and views of the different types of vegetation found along Sabah's mighty Kinabatangan River. We will be on a lookout for the mangrove specials. This is where the mangrove forest of the coast merges into the more familiar riverine forest of the Kinabatangan River. Abai borders one of the most important wildlife refuges, the Kinabatangan Wildlife Sanctuary. Check-in at the Kinabatangan Wetlands Resort, a newly established resort nestled in the pristine mangrove and fresh water forest, secluded at the edge of the RAMSAR site. Check-in and have a cup of coffee and local cakes while you are briefed about the lodging and the activities. Later, set off for the afternoon cruise in search of the mangrove specials, river sceneries, village landscapes and more wildlife. On good weather, we may even get to see firefly colonies which are found at certain parts of the river. Cruise back to KWR for dinner at the common area. After dinner, proceed for guided night walk for nocturnal wildlife.

Day Three

Early morning cruise to observe more wildlife and birdlife. We shall cruise to the nearby Oxbow Lake, Danau Pitas to explore the area. Return to Resort for breakfast. We shall spend another river cruise in the late afternoon and night cruise after dinner.

Day Four

After breakfast, check-out and return to Sandakan by boat. The 1½ hours boat cruise shall pass fishing villages along the coast. Also a good chance to photograph Sandakan town from the seafront. Transfer to Sandakan Airport for your flight departure onwards.
